The program should educate youth about all forms of tobacco use including smoking and smokeless tobacco use and should include the following:</p>

The school-based prevention program will involve parents or families to support the school-based program</li> </ul>	-TNT curriculum trainings and TOT include this information  -CMT for Tobacco ( <i>Community Mobilization Training</i> ) available to involve parents / community in school based program  -TA available related to parent / community involvement - \$40/hr (ESC to estimate # hours needed)

The training should include reviewing the curriculum, modeling instructional activities, and providing opportunities to practice implementing the lessons</li> </ul>	<p><b>Options:</b>  <u>2-day TNT ToT on-site</u> for ESC staff/ community coalition members, etc - \$5544 + materials (max 20 participants)   <u>1-day on-site TNT curriculum training</u> - \$3150 + materials (max 50 participants)   <u>TNT curriculum training online</u> - \$2500 + materials (max 30 participants)   <u>5-day on-site SAPST for Tobacco</u> (<i>Substance Abuse Prevention Specialist Training</i>) (includes TNT curriculum training) - \$9250 + materials (max 40 participants)   <u>3-day CMT for Tobacco training</u> - \$7500 + materials (max 25 participants)   <b>NOTE: TNT curriculum training and ToT both include TEKS / TNT crosswalk</b></p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ An evaluation component to assess the tobacco prevention program outcomes at regular intervals</li> </ul>	<p>Evaluation of implementation provided and evaluation report draft compiled. Pre-post test summation and analysis provided - \$6,000 (see Below)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Local school district participation in the Youth Tobacco Survey conducted by the Department of State Health Services to monitor the state's youth tobacco use.</li> </ul>	<p>TA provided by SWPC staff related to school's participation - \$40/ hr (ESC will need to estimate # of TA hours needed)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ A final program evaluation based on required performance measures to include the number of students served and the number of teachers trained in the program. The report will be due to the ESC on 6/11/2010 and TEA on 8/1/2010.</li> </ul>	<p>Evaluation of implementation provided and evaluation report draft compiled. Pre-post test summation and analysis provided. \$6,000</p>
